

## **ICE Proud Member Logo Usage Policy**

The ICE *Proud Member* logo is owned solely and exclusively by the Institute for Credentialing Excellence (ICE). By virtue of this policy, ICE provides to members in good standing a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to use the *Proud Member* logo for the purpose of identifying their membership in ICE. The ICE *Proud Member* logo may not be used in any manner that, as determined in the sole judgment of ICE, suggests or implies that: a member is in any way an agent of ICE; ICE in any way warrants, approves, or endorses any product or service provided by the member; or the programs have received accreditation through an ICE accreditation service program. The ICE *Proud Member* logo may not be used in any manner that, as determined in the sole judgment of ICE, discredits or reflects poorly upon ICE. The ICE *Proud Member* logo may not be altered in any manner.

The ICE *Proud Member* logo can be used on a member's business cards, letterhead, and promotional materials, including the organization's web site. Any other use of the ICE *Proud Member* logo not specifically enumerated must be approved by ICE. Individual members are prohibited from allowing their employer to use the ICE *Proud Member* logo on the employer's letterhead or promotional materials or in any way that implies the individual member's organization is a member of ICE. The license to use the ICE *Proud Member* logo shall terminate and be revoked upon the member's failure to remain in good standing, in the event of misuse by the member as determined by ICE, or any other breach of this Logo Usage Policy. Upon such termination and/or revocation, the member will remove the ICE *Proud Member* logo from all materials, products, and services, regardless of whether such materials, products, and services are preprinted or pre-existing at that time.

Any organization or individual found in violation of the above policy or unauthorized use of the ICE *Proud Member* logo will be subject to potential loss of membership, trademark infringement liability, and such other remedies as may be available to ICE.
